HOME/NEIGHBORHOOD/PEERS (physical description, criminal/gang activity, etc.):

The home is located in the northern part of Cincinnati. Blue Ash is the community. The neighborhood is middle class to upper class. The neighborhood is well protected by the Blue Ash Police Department. The community is heavily involved with local law enforcement and other community improvement projects. No gang activity within the neighborhood. The house itself is a well-kept two-story with five bedrooms and 4,000 square feet of space. Parents are well respected in the community.

FAMILY STATUS (composition, interactions, at-risk family members, attitude, support capabilities, etc.):

The parents and Kevin's 9-year old sister, Marsha, will be living at the above address. They appear to be very supportive and are a close knit family. All are looking forward to starting a fresh new life in Blue Ash. There are many programs in the community for Kevin. Dr. and Mrs. Mason and their daughter are willing to attend family counseling sessions with Kevin.

FAMILY EMPLOYMENT/FINANCIAL RESOURCES (If proposed placement resource works, who will supervise the juvenile):

Dr. Mason will be working at St. Jude's Hospital. Mrs. Mason is a homemaker and will be available to supervise Kevin when he is not attending school.

LEGAL HISTORY OF FAMILY (current charges, probation or parole status):

Both Dr. and Mrs. Mason denied any difficulty with the law – no outstanding warrants, current or previous probation or parole records. Background checks were done on the family members. They are all in good standing.

PROPOSED PLAN (school/employment, court-ordered conditions, treatment needs):

Kevin will enroll in an educational program where he can obtain either his high school diploma or GED certificate. Blue Ash is very close to Kenwood Mall which has plenty of part-time jobs. Kevin will obtain a part-time job to help pay his restitution. He will give his JPO copies of his pay stubs and copies of payments made to Florida’s designee for restitution. Kevin must agree to follow all conditions of probation, particularly conditions 12-15 (not violating any local, state or federal laws). Kevin has a potentially bright future ahead of him here in Blue Ash.

OTHER COMMENTS (recommendations, questions, concerns):

Kevin has a very supportive and loving family. They believe that once he is away from his negative peer influence, Kevin will make a successful adjustment. The community will work with Kevin and his family in his transition back to being a positive member of society.
