PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT LEGIBLY

When to complete this form: This form is used for voluntary return of juvenile to home/ demanding state. The juvenile is requested to sign the ICJ Form III after being advised by the judge of his/her rights. It is recommended that the Juvenile Rights form be used with Form III. Form III must be signed by the juvenile in the presence of a judge and be signed by the judge and legal counsel/guardian *ad litem*, if appointed.

Juvenile's Name: Insert juvenile's name.

Name and Address of Legal Guardian or Custodian: Insert name and address, including city and state, of individual(s), court or agency to which the juvenile will be returned.

Judge's Name and Court of Jurisdiction: Insert name of judge and court in the holding state.

Legal Guardian/Custodian: Repeat information from Line 2.

Date and Juvenile's Signature: Insert the date of juvenile's appearance in court and have juvenile sign.

Unaccompanied OR Accompanied by boxes: Check the appropriate box. Most juveniles are returned via commercial airlines to the demanding states unaccompanied. If a change of planes is required, airport supervision will be arranged by the demanding state's ICJ office. If a juvenile needs to be escorted, the demanding state should be made aware of the situation as soon as possible. If the juvenile will be accompanied, insert name of person or agency contact who will accompany the juvenile.

Date and Judge's Signature: Insert date and have judge sign. This form is not valid without the signature of a judge.

TO BE COMPLETED ONLY IF COUNSEL OR GUARDIAN AD LITEM IS APPOINTED: Leave this section blank if no Counsel or Guardian *Ad Litem* has been appointed.

DETAILED PHYSICAL AND CLOTHING DESCRIPTION OF JUVENILE & CONTACT

INFORMATION: *This information is vital to the return process.* Complete this section with as much detail as possible. The clothing described must be the clothing that the juvenile will wear while traveling. This information is used to identify the juvenile for airport supervision and pickup at the final destination. If the clothing description is not available at the time of the juvenile's court appearance, this information must be supplied to your ICJ office as soon as possible.

Home/Demanding State's contact name, address and phone #: Insert name and phone number of home/demanding state person or agency who should be notified or contacted with additional information or if problems should arise.
